

High flyers!



What makes a ceiling cooling/heating system a good one? Is there a noticeable difference from floor heating or wall heating/-cooling? And perhaps the most important question: when is ceiling cooling/heating absolutely necessary?

In the field of ceiling cooling/heating in particular, consumers are presented with a confusing flood of different products and possible solutions. We can tell you why you should choose Variotherm.

Ceiling cooling? What a luxury!

Not true. In modern architecture in particular, and in any areas where large glass window surfaces are planned, ceiling cooling is almost an absolute must. This also applies to lightweight constructions, where there is a lack of storage mass. Despite insulation, rooms can therefore easily become overheated. This problem is compounded by legal stipulations, for example that the maximum room temperature at a workstation may not exceed 26°C. However, this aside, ceiling cooling offers a degree of comfort that you will never want to do without once you have experienced it.

Ceiling heating? Sounds pretty good!

Indeed it is. However, during the planning stage, a precise inspection needs to be made of the room and its parameters. The first method of choice should be a wall heating and/or floor heating system. However, when it is used correctly in offices and attic extensions, a ceiling heating system is a great alternative or supplement that we can highly recommend.

Cooling? Heating? Or both?

It's the combination that makes the difference! The Variotherm Modular Ceilings can be used for both cooling and heating. We therefore recommend that you always include ceiling heating in your calculations during planning. As a supplement to wall heating/cooling and/or floor heating, you will certainly be making a good, energy-efficient choice.







For decades, Bilbao was considered to be the epitome of a factory town dominated by grey heavy industry. During the past 20 years, Bilbao has succeeded in becoming more sustainable in many areas.

One example of this is the Azurmendi building complex about 20 minutes outside of Bilbao. The top floor of the building, which has been constructed according to environmental criteria, is home to the top-class restaurant "Azurmendi". The bright, generously proportioned rooms with floor-to-ceiling windows offer a spectacular view onto the Basque landscape and also offer visitors a glimpse into the restaurant's own vegetable garden and vineyards, along with its own winery. 

Ten years ago, the architect duo Heri and Salli from façade manufacturers FOB were awarded the contract of designing the futuristic OFFICE OFF building project. 86 draft model designs and countless studies later, the unusual living and working space can now be seen in a tailor-made façade covering made of wood.





"From the moment we began to think in wood, a huge number of problems began to be resolved," said architect Heribert Wolfmayr when asked about his new interpretation of a treehouse that was completed in the spring of 2013 and which attracted a lot of attention in the architectural world. The choice of spruce in the interior spaces, larch on the façade and the extremely durable Canadian arolla pine for the roof shingles turned out to be an excellent decision, which also won the Austrian building owner prize.

In the rooms, which in some cases are open across three storeys, the wood used gives the building its very own kind of acoustics and warmth. You always have the feeling of being enclosed in a very comfortable way. This is just what the building owner, Johannes Stimakovits, wanted to achieve. As a façade manufacturer, it was important to him from the beginning to bring his experience to bear and create a building that was as independent as possible in terms of energy use. He developed his own sliding window, for example, which opens during overheating in summer or when the CO₂ levels are too high and allows the cool air from the wooded hill nearby to flow in.

The perfect heating match for this was found in the form of a wood gasification oven and buffer storage tank in combination with VarioRoll floor heating laid over 570 m². With its light construction and flexibility in terms of installation, this system also offers comfort in the high rooms. One special feature is certainly the manual firing of the oven. Entirely in keeping with the team spirit principle, a different colleague is assigned the task of heating every week. At the weekends, the boss takes over the heating himself.




Key factor skirting heating system

Built in 1717 in beautiful Saxony, the Faktorenhof is a valuable listed building which could be described as a rural baroque gem. Apparently, the person who ordered the mansion to be built was an artistically-minded canvas dealer who had gained his wealth from overseas trade. We are sure that he, too, would have appreciated the new skirting heating in the building.

The chronicler Dr. Edmund Wauer describes the Faktorenhof, which is now owned by the local municipality of Eibau, as a pearl among Eibau baroque buildings. On the ground floor of the main building, which was constructed in the traditional Oberlausitz regional style, there is a wood-panelled room made from large coniferous timber beams. Today, it houses the local tourist information centre of the "Spreequell" region where the river Spree has its source. Here, visitors can receive information on events, the local sights, places to eat and stay, holiday apartments and much more.

The building, which has been maintained with the utmost care over the centuries, has remained largely in its original state. It went without question that a great deal of thought would have to be put into selecting the right heating system. Following approval of the listed buildings preservation office, a total of 100 running metres of Classic skirting heating were installed. The skirting heating system fits perfectly into the historical ambience. In this way, the mansion was spared almost all structural interventions. Quick to regulate and visually appealing, the Classic skirting heating is a perfect heating solution that in commercial terms would have been met with full approval by the open-minded former owner of the house.
